

Won't there be more crime in a tunnel?

Notes:

- (1) The robberies in 2000 and 2006 were reported on trains.
- (2) The assault of 2001 was reported on a train.
- (3) The larceny offenses reported were thefts from autos and bicycles.
- (4) The destruction of property incidents were a combination broken windows, scratches, or other damage to autos in the parking lot.

No crimes were reported in the 'small tunnel' for the seven-year period reviewed.
